

Pastor Sue's April 2024 Newsletter

Ted Loder's Easter poem begins with this paragraph:

Lord of such amazing surprises as put a catch in my breath and wings on my heart,

I praise you for this joy, too great for words, but not for tears and songs and sharing;

for this mercy that blots out my betrayals and bids me begin again,

to limp on, to hop-skip-and-jump on,

to mend what is broken in and around me,

and to forgive the breakers. . .

Even though I love Christmas, it is Easter that my soul needs each year. I need the discipline of Lent, with its extra weekly worship service and daily devotions written just for that time. I need to be engulfed by the purple paraments, banners, and candles, reminding me that in their beauty is a call to repentance. I need to see the altar stripped of everything that reminds us of our weekly worship—no more candles, worship book, communion vessels; everything is taken away to focus on the death of our Savior.

And let's not forget Good Friday. The statue of Jesus covered in black, the altar, pulpit, and cross, all completely covered in black. The slam of the Bible, the dimming of the lights, the darkness as the cross is carried out.

I need to be with Jesus as He is led away after celebrating Passover with His disciples, betrayed by one of His own. I need to hear the sound of the whip, the ridicule of the soldiers, the pounding of the nails, His cry of agony and despair. The silence of His death.

I need to follow the women to the tomb on Easter morning and to be surprised by a joy that no words could ever comprehend. The "amazing surprises that puts a catch in my breath and wings on my heart." Yes, I need to then hop, skip, and jump to know that what is broken is now mended and that as Jesus forgave the one who betrayed Him, so do I need to "forgive the breakers."

May your Holy Week and Easter be a time of blessing. Journey with Jesus to the cross and then wait and watch for a joy, too great for words, but not too great for tears and songs and sharing.

Confirmation will be May 19. Please continue to support our confirmation students.




